

BURN THE FLOOR – Sat Feb 18 at DF Dance Studio

-What to expect-

- **ARRIVAL – CHECK IN**
 - All competitors should check in between 5:30pm and 6pm at the front desk to receive their wristband and competition number (leaders and ladies styling competitors will wear a number on their backs). Please remember that competition fees are \$15 for your first category, \$5 per additional category. Competition fees must be PAID IN FULL before you will receive your wristband and number.
 - Every competitor can get one spectator in for free! Spectators will give the competitor's name at the front desk to receive their free wristband for admission. Otherwise, admission is \$10 per person. Doors will open for spectators to enter the Grand Ballroom at 6:30pm. Seating is general admission – early spectators will get first choice for seating. Admission does not guarantee a seat. 100 chairs will be set up, and then standing room will be available.
- **COMPETITION FLOW**
 - Competition will start promptly at 7pm. The schedule of the competition categories will be posted to teams slack on Friday Feb 17, and will be posted in backstage area for your reference. The front studio will be the “backstage area” – please be lined up with your partner the category before your event.
 - Shortly after each round, a call back list will be posted in the backstage area. Call backs will line up to compete at the next round. There will be a competition coordinator backstage to help you if you have questions.
 - IF YOU HAVE TWO PARTNERS: Your first round will be split into two heats and you will dance in both heats (one right after the other), one with each partner. If both partners get called back for the second round, you must CHOOSE one partner. The other partner will select a new partner from the eliminated contestants.
 - When you're not competing, you are welcome to watch. Please enter/exit the grand ballroom in an orderly manner with the approval of the backstage competition coordinator. Please do not take spectator seats since there are so few – we ask that you stand instead.
 - After awards ceremonies, we will turn on music for social dancing until 11pm! Please stick around and enjoy.
- **FEEDBACK EXPECTATIONS**
 - The entire competition will be filmed and then posted on Vimeo for you to see how you did. The judges will be filling out scoresheets that will be available at the team practice the following week. In addition to that, the video will serve as another source for feedback. During team practices in following weeks, your coaches will give verbal feedback to help you set and reach for new goals.
 - Pro/am showcase performers will also receive scoresheets in the end of competition. They will have these scoresheets and the online video as their main sources of feedback. Pro/am showcase students receive these scoresheets in lieu of awards, ribbons, etc.
